Minutes: Minutes of the meeting held on April 16, 2019 were approved as submitted with a motion by Shane Hegarty, second by Dr. Alicia Long, and a vote of All Ayes.

Agenda:

1. Director's Report: Department Updates

Maintenance/Projects

- Removal of pitching mound on Field 2 at Founder's Park. The department now has 4 portable pitching mounds.
- Meadows Park-Waiting on an agreement then will begin to look at design options.
- No Name Park- Changes to be made to the culvert in order to meet Army Corp of Engineering requirements. Discussion of options to meet the requirements and the pricing associated with the changes.
- Christmas lights along Lake Saint Louis Boulevard went out for bid.
- Splash Pad at Zachary's Playground has a pipe leak. Discussed temporary attempts to keep it open through Labor Day. Repairs to be made in off season.

Programming and Special Events

- Triathlon-Review of the efforts made to avoid cancelation of the event and the decision to cancel.
- Fall baseball and fall soccer leagues both underway. Fall soccer saw some growth in registration numbers.
- Upcoming events include the final concert of the summer series and the last Movie in the Park in October. Planning for the Veterans Day Ceremony and Halloween event is underway.

2. Great Rivers Greenway-St. Charles Master Plan

- The Director of Parks gave highlights from the Great Rivers Greenway Master Plan Kick-off meeting and its vision for St. Charles County. Timeline of the planning process was presented to the board. Great Rivers Greenway development of the Master Plan is underway.

3. Playground at Founder's Park- Flooring Options/Recommendations

- Discussion of flooring options and cost saving efforts. The Director of Parks the possibility of rubber mulch to meet safety standards. Rubber mulch will only require 6 inches to be laid verses 9 inches of wood mulch. Board suggestion of installing 2 inches of rubber mulch on top of the existing pour in place was made. Further research on rubber mulch options will be made.

4. LSL Program/Rental Fees – FY 2019/2020


- This item has been postponed to the September meeting.
