

BOARD OF ALDERMEN
SPECIAL MEETING
MAY 3, 2021
(JOURNAL AND MINUTES)

The Board of Aldermen for the City of Lake Saint Louis, Missouri met in Special Session on Monday, May 3, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL:

Mayor Jason Law, presided over the meeting. Aldermen present were Tom Mispagel, Ward II; Gary Torlina, Ward I; Jacalyn Schauer, Ward I; Karen Vennard, Ward II; and Chris Hinkle, Ward III. Also present were: George Ertle, City Administrator; Sarah Belcher, Assistant City Administrator; Donna Daniel, City Clerk; Derek Koestel, Public Works Director; Darren Noelken, Parks and Recreation Director; Chad Layton, Police Captain; and Louis Clayton, Community Development Director.

PURPOSE OF MEETING:

Mayor Law stated the purpose of the Special Meeting is to select a successor to fill the vacant office for Alderman Ward III, an un-expired term ending in April, 2022.

GENERAL DISCUSSION:

Mayor Law introduced Justin Hensley and his family. Mayor Law explained why he thought Mr. Hensley would be a good candidate for Alderman, Ward III.

The Board held a brief discussion about the vacant office.

APPOINTMENTS:

MOTION TO APPROVE:

Alderman Torlina made a motion to approve the Mayor's recommended appointment. The motion was seconded by Alderman Vennard; the poll of the Board being ayes: Torlina, Vennard, Hinkle, Schauer and Mispagel. Nays, none. The motion passed. Mr. Hensley was appointed to the Office of Lake Saint Louis Alderman, Ward III with a term ending in April, 2022, coinciding with the elected officials' terms that also end in April, 2022.
