Minutes: Minutes of the meeting held on December 15, 2020 were approved as submitted with a motion by Shane Hegarty, second by Dr. Alicia Long, and a vote of All Ayes.

Agenda:

1. Boulevard Playground-Existing handprints
 - Parks director working with contractor to try to preserve handprints in the original concrete by having the prints cut out.
 - Families of handprints to cover expenses of this service. There is no guarantee the handprints will survive the removal.
 - Park Board discussed the idea of having a message board with the history of the park and handprints.
2. Deer Ridge Park- Grand Opening
 - Grand Opening and Ribbon Cutting Ceremony scheduled for April 1, 2021 and is weather dependent.
 - Parks maintenance staff have been busy with final details of the park before its Grand Opening. Shelters, education pieces, signage and mulch have all been installed.
3. Programming/Event Updates
 - The City has partnered with St. Charles County Parks and Day Camp will be held at Quail Ridge Park.
 - i. Camp to utilize the lodge for indoor time and in times of inclement weather.
 - ii. St. Charles County to provide a park ranger to incorporate enrichment into the summer camp program: will include fishing, hikes, and opportunities for educational discussions.
 - Triathlon will be sprint course only
 - Baseball begins this week.
 - Laser leveling is scheduled and will allow the use of Boulevard baseball fields again.
 - Kona Ice is now running the concession stand.
 - Movies and Concerts all have been scheduled.

- Memorial Day Ceremony will be held virtually again.

4. Project Updates


- Contract approved by Board of Alderman for Founders Park parking lot and Boulevard Park Amphitheater pathway asphalt.

 - ii. Glades restoration at Deer Ridge
 - iii. Lights at Veterans Memorial Park
 - iv. Camera Upgrades at Founders
 - v. Add loop to parking lot near Founders Park fields 4 and 5.
 - vi. Updates and ADA upgrades to Founders Park facilities

- Discussion on complaints received about parks not owned or maintained by the City.
