Bill No. 4791 – An ordinance to ratify a contract with the State Emergency Management Agency (SEMA) for the purpose of receiving grant monies to provide salary reimbursement for emergency management positions on behalf of the City of Lake Saint Louis.

FIRST READING:

Alderman Hensley made a motion to authorize the first reading of Bill No. 4791. The motion was seconded by Alderman Schauer and passed unanimously. Bill No. 4791 was read.

SECOND READING:

Alderman Hensley made a motion to authorize the second reading of Bill No. 4791. The motion was seconded by Alderman Schauer and passed unanimously. Bill No. 4791 was read.

MOTION TO PASS AND ADOPT THE SECOND READING OF BILL NO. 4791 AND ADOPT THE SAME BY ASSIGNING ORDINANCE NO. 4568.

Alderman Hensley made a motion to approve the second reading of Bill No. 4791 and pass the same by assigning Ordinance No. 4568. The motion was seconded by Alderman Schauer; the poll of the Board being ayes: Hensley, Schauer, Mispagel, and Grassmuck. Nays, none. Alderman Mathison and Alderman Hinkle were absent. The motion passed.

Bill No. 4792 – An ordinance deleting Section 215.2170 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lake Saint Louis relating to the sale and distribution of tobacco-related paraphernalia.
